Through its program **Brasil no Mundo**, **Projeto Paradiso** aims to boost the presence of Brazilian talents, projects and films at the world's major international markets and festivals.



Synopsis: January 2019. Filmmaker Karim Aïnouz decides to get on a boat and cross the Mediterranean, embarking on his first journey to Algeria.

Accompanied by the memory of his mother Iracema and his camera, Aïnouz gives us a detailed account of the journey to his father's homeland; from the sea crossing to his arrival at the Atlas Mountains in Kabylia - a mountainous region in northern Algeria - to his return. Interweaving present, past and future.

Synopsis: In a Mexican mountain village, three young girls turn abandoned houses into their private playgrounds. They disguise themselves as women out of sight of others, and find refuge in hiding places to escape those who might kidnap them. But the dark echoes of violence become an inescapable threat.

Synopsis: Brazil, present days. Mariana, 21 years old, belongs to a world where she must do her utmost to keep up the appearance of a perfect Christian woman. In order to resist temptation, she and her girlfriends try their best to control everything and everyone around them. And that includes the town sinners. At night, the girls' squad put on masks and go out to hunt and beat up all the women who have deviated from the path of righteousness. However, the day will come when the urge to scream will be stronger than it has ever been...

Synopsis: The employer is a young man who apparently has everything going on for him, except one pressing concern: his baby's health. The employee is looking for a job to support his newborn too. He does not hesitate when the employer decides to hire him to work on his lands. Both will meet their needs by helping each other. But one day an accident happens. This unexpected event will strain the ties between them, endangering the fate of the two families.





Projeto Paradiso and the Argentinian market Ventana Sur are happy to launch a new partnership during the Marché du Film: the Paradiso WIP Award. It will grant a US\$ 10,000 prize to a fiction feature film in the post production stage, selected by a special jury appointed by Ventana Sur. Fiction feature films with a majority or minority co-production in Brazil are eligible for the prize. The selected project will have a special screening during Ventana Sur.

Ventana Sur is the most important Latin American audiovisual market, organized by the **National Institute of Cinema and Audiovisual Arts** (INCAA) and the **Marché du Film - Cannes Film Festival**. It is scheduled to take place in Buenos Aires from November 29th to December 3rd, 2021.



Bárbara Cunha is a member of **Projeto Paradiso's Talents Network**. Professionals from our network are eligible to receive additional **supports for their careers**.

She is a co-founder and partner of 99 Produções, and has directed three documentary series as well as the feature film *Prison Flower* (2019). She is currently working on her first two fiction films: *Child Bride* and *The Field of Guara Wolves*, chosen to participate in the **Paradiso Incubator 2020**.

Her documentary feature film *God is Woman* was selected for *Docs in Progress - Marché du Film*. The director received our support to participate in the market, where she will pitch and present an excerpt of the film to festival programmers and sales agents.



Launched at the online edition of Marché du Film 2020, Brave New World - the Future of Cinema is a web series of interviews with key players of the audiovisual market available on our YouTube channel, Canal Paradiso. At this edition of the Festival de Cannes, we are launching two episodes: one with Aleksandra Zakharchenko, about the impACT program at the Marché, and another with Anita da Rocha Silveira and Vania Catani, director and producer of Medusa, her first feature film that premiers at the 2021 Directors' Fortnight.



Projeto Paradiso is a philantropic initiative that provides high-value support mechanisms for Brazilian talents in the audiovisual sector with a focus on fiction films and series that connect with their audiences. We invest in professional training and capacity building and nurture a network of professionals in Brazil.
