**Logline**: Matias is in an intense affair with a mysterious man. Between the search for fame, secrets, and sex in public spaces, their relationship is crossed by a murder that could tear both their worlds apart.



As a result of the partnership between Projeto Paradiso and the Berlinale Co-Production Market, a delegation of five up-and-coming Brazilian producers connected to Projeto Paradiso will participate in the Visitors Programme. The young and talented professionals will also take part in the European Film Market (EFM).



**Bárbara Defanti** is a creative producer and line producer. Founder of **Sobretudo Produção**, a production company based in Rio de Janeiro, produced and released the documentaries "A place to take away" and "Meia Hora and the headlines that made the headlines". In fiction, she recently premiered her first feature and international co-production, **"The Club of Angels"**, last November during PÖFF - Tallinn Black Nights FF.



**Daniela Marinho** is a Brazilian producer, with a Master's degree in Communication. She is also a Law student. With more than a decade of experience in production, she produced more than 50 film releases and worked in different roles in **25 short** and **6 feature films**.



Fernanda Vidigal is specialized in film production at the International Film and TV School (EICTV/Cuba) and graduated in Film and Audiovisual at UNA University Center (Belo Horizonte/Brazil). Talent Paradiso (2019/Brazil) and Berlinale Talents Guadalajara (2020/Mexico), she created and runs the production company Carapiá Filmes, based in Belo Horizonte/MG.



Heverton Lima is a founder of Paideia Filmes. His work includes the launch production of The Edge of Democracy (2019) and the executive production of all Paideia's films. Heverton's films have been screened in festivals like Visions du Réel, Bafici and Havana Film Festival and were awarded prizes at Curitiba International Film Festival, Lovers Film Festival – Torino LGBTQI Visions, and Mix Brasil.



**Thais Vidal** is a producer, researcher and screenwriter and is currently a PhD student in Social Communication (UFPE). With Ponte Produtoras, she produced features and shorts that circulated in important national and international festivals. Currently, in addition to production, she works on script and direction and will attend the **Master of Creative Writing** at **EICTV**.
