Powerful stories, inspiring visions, and captivating characters from diverse backgrounds continue to connect us, deepening our sense of empathy and mutual understanding.

On this journey, it has been our **joy to** continue contributing to the industry

through Paradiso programs. Through our program *Brasil no Mundo*, which supports national presence at festivals and markets across the globe, we launched new grants, **reaffirming our commitment to elevating our professionals and their work** onto the global stage and further consolidating ourselves as agents of change

We look forward to celebrating five years of Project Paradiso's activities in 2024. We can't wait to **commemorate more achievements and unforgettable stories** alongside the Brazilian audiovisual industry's talent.

OLGA RABINOVICH

President-Founder Olga Rabinovich Institute Projeto Paradiso Reconstruction and diversity were keywords for the Brazilian audiovisual industry in 2023.

The federal government made significant advances in this direction: the Ministry of Culture was reestablished, allowing for the return of the National Secretariat for Audiovisual Bureau and the National Agency for Cinema (Ancine)'s public policies and the reinstatement of governance, teams, and values.

We were incredibly proud to see the inauguration of Superior Cinema Council - for the first time with gender and regional parity - and full of members from the Paradiso Talent Network! We also saw state and municipal bodies gain momentum. At the end of the year, we received good news regarding projects and films financed by a body of laws and public support schemes, and we rejoice in the idea they will be shot and screened in the upcoming years.

If, during difficult times, Projeto Paradiso made a point of remaining flexible and agile when adapting to the demands of the Brazilian audiovisual industry, now, in this new context, we seek new ways to contribute to this ecosystem.

That is why, in 2023, we focused our planning and efforts on values we believe in: **promoting**

diversity within the Brazilian audiovisual

industry. For the first time, we offered a Paradiso Scholarship exclusively for a Black or indigenous professional to attend a Residency in Colombia. In partnership with the organization Instituto Nicho 54, we launched a career acceleration program for Black professionals (Aceleradora Paradiso).

Focused on directing, the first edition was a collaboration with André Novais de Oliveira (Filmes de Plástico) during the shooting of *O Dia que te Conheci* (The Day I Met You), a feature that has since been winning awards at festivals in Brazil and around the world.

To contribute to a greater plurality in narratives,

one more faithful to the Brazilian reality and in line with initiatives to decentralize audiovisual production, we turned our attention to projects beyond the south and southeast regions. We expanded partnerships with institutions based in the north, northeast, and center-west of Brazil, reinforcing our presence at events promoted outside of the São Paulo/Rio de Janeiro hub. We increased our commitment and investments to benefit professionals from the Paradiso Talent Network from these underserved regions with exclusive opportunities.

We innovated to support distribution in cinemas and stimulate the commercial release of Brazilian feature films, offering an unprecedented award at the São Paulo International Film Festival.

The winner was Saudade Fez Morada Aqui Dentro

(Longing Made a Home Within) by Haroldo Borges. In addition, we helped bring to Brazil for the first time a workshop by French partner Series Mania Institute, aimed at developing series projects in coproduction.

We had the joy of witnessing projects and films involving professionals of the Paradiso Talent Network gain more and more recognition in the national market and international scene. Such as *Pedágio* (Toll Stop) by Carolina Markowicz, whose trajectory we have followed and supported since 2020, and *Levante* (Power Alley) by Lillah Halla, produced by Clarissa Guarilha and Rafaella Costa, edited by Eva Randolph and Grace Passô - all five of whom are members of our network.

These are just some of the individual cases that make our eyes shine. In 2024, we will work so our paths move toward a more diverse and healthy audiovisual industry that continues to win hearts worldwide.


Between 2019 and 2023, Projeto Paradiso supported 117 fellows in the audiovisual market from nineteen states and all five regions of Brazil.


Regions where fellows were supported in previous years.




2019-2023 Talent Profile





INCUBADORA PARADISO



Incubadora Paradiso (Paradiso Incubator) is a training program aimed at developing feature-length fiction projects.

Its objective is to promote international co-productions of high artistic value and foster the professional development of participants – independent and debut screenwriters, directors, and producers in their first or second feature films.

Over a period of six months, the Incubadora offers selected projects financial resources for screenwriters, as well as mentoring and networking activities - all to expand their potential. The projects also benefit from consulting, workshops, and other services, as well as incentives for their participation in national and international events.
















BRASIL NO MUNDO

WORKSHOPS AND LABS



First Cut Lab Paradiso Brasil

This international training and consultancy program, designed by Matthieu Darras, was brought to Brazil by Projeto Paradiso. The second edition benefited two fiction feature films in initial editing stage: A Mulher Fantasma (The Woman Who Cries), by George Walker Torres, produced by Antonio Gonçalves Junior, and Pasárgada (photo), by Dira Paes, produced by Eliane Ferreira.



SeriesMania Workshop Rio

With support from RioFilme (from Rio's Department of Culture), SICAV, FIRJAN, Institut Français de Paris, and the French Embassy, eight producer/showrunner duos from across the country participated in the first SeriesMania Institute organized outside of France.



BrLab Audience Design

BrLab organized this tailor-made workshop for projects from the Paradiso Incubator and the Paradiso Talent Network. Participants were trained in audience design in order to create communication, distribution, and engagement strategies. The Lab included special participation from consultants Rafael Sampaio, Marina Tabaray, Síle Culley, Florencia Gil, and Frédéric Corvez.



FRAPA [LAB]

The 5th edition of **FRAPA[LAB]**, focused on developing fiction projects, was co-produced with Projeto Paradiso, offering training and network opportunities with experts.

AWARDS

Throughout 2023, we awarded 12 prizes to professionals and projects.



This award was granted to Laís Araújo's Infantaria (Infantry), to participate in MAFF (Málaga Fund & Co-production Event) at the 2024 Malaga Festival, Spain. The project, Orchestra, by **Urânia Munzanzu**, produced by Acaraje Film's Flávia Santana. was the other Paradiso Prize winner - granting a space for the producer at the TFL Meeting Event in Italy.



This award is dedicated to fiction feature film scripts written by women. In 2023, the winner was **Carol Rodrigues**, for her feature film, *Criadas* (Sister-maids).





The feature film project Estrangeiro de Si (Stranger to Oneself), by Nilo Rivas and Guilherme Ramos. won the Paradiso Award for a project developed at the Cena 15 lab. Festa Santa (Saint Feast). by **Leônidas** Oliveira and Ton Zaranza, won the BAL-LAB Award to participate in the co-production meeting at the Biarritz Festival, in France.






Roadmap to Financing



O primeiro semestre reúne dois eventos importantes no calendário global da industria audiovisual, além do Oscar. Em fevereiro, o Festival de Berlim, na Alemanha, e em maio o Festival de Cannes, na França.

Nesta 73ª edição do festival alemão, já foi visivel a diferença em relação aos anos anteriores, marcados pelo congelamento dos programas públicos de exportação do cinema brasileiro, resultado do ententações políticas devastadoras. Cinco filmes estavam em competição, três projetos foram selecionados para o mercado de coprodução, 83 profissionais participaram do European Film Market, e ainda estiveram por lá organizações como Spcine, Cinema do Brasil e NI-CHO 54. O Projeto Paradiso, iniciativa filantrópica que há quatro anos incentiva o audiovisual nacional, apoioua presença do país por meio do seu programa Brasil no Mundo.

Chamou a atenção que, pela primeira vez desde 2018, a Embaixada do Brasil tenha voltado a abrir as portas para receber os profissionais brasileiros em Berlim. O Itamaraty, além dea poiar cineastas no Berlinale Talents, contribuiu para que profissionais de filmes selectionados participassem do festival. Também pela primeira vez em quatro anos, a Agência Nacional do Cinema enviou um representante a evento intenucional. Não são episódios anódinos, mas sinais de uma mudança de ventos e de um futuro melhor.
